## Called to be Great Followers 8/4/2020

Have you ever stood in the "Self-Help" section of a bookstore? With a book you can master everything from Accounting to Zoology. One topic was glaringly missing. "How to be a Great Follower." There were dozens of books on Leadership, but not one on Followership.

Our world does not value being a follower. We want our voice to be heard. We want to be in front, stand out from the crowd and be in control. We are challenged to be independent and make our own path, to take charge and blaze the trail. Being a great follower just doesn't resonate with today's culture.

It truly resonated with Jesus, though. Twenty-two times in the gospels Jesus gave the command to "Follow me." Guess how many times Jesus called his disciples to be a leader, a master, ruler or lord? None. Why? Because there is only one leader, only one head to the body, only one ruler, Master and Lord. We are called to be great followers.

In **Matthew 8:20-22** Jesus is speaking to a man who claimed he wanted to be Jesus' disciple. However, he had to bury his father first. Was Jesus uncaring when he said, "Let the dead bury their dead. You follow me." No. Rather, Jesus is reminding us all that people who follow Christ have a life that transcends human existence.

Being a follower takes precedence over everything. When you follow Jesus, He will make you a leader. His words to his disciples prove that. "Follow me and I will make you a fisher of men." Following comes first, leadership comes later. And, you don't learn how to lead from a self-help book. You trust Jesus... and, as His follower, He will make you into the leader He needs.
