Forgiveness on the Baseball Diamond 3/15/2022

It was a gorgeous summer day. The players were eager. Wads of gum were heartily chewed, and oversized t-shirts with matching logos were proudly worn. It was 2nd & 3rd grade T-ball. The coaches were from the Varsity baseball team, and the stands were dotted with parents and grandparents.

One youngster stepped to the plate, swung with all his might and dribbled the ball to the pitcher's mound. He made it to 1st base on a play that included only 3 errors. The next boy had a more athletic build. He swatted the ball through the infield and into shallow left field. He tore off for first base. The boy on first base ran to second and stopped. The coach standing on 3rd base hollered, "Come on, Come on!" The second boy, having rounded first was right on the heels of the first boy. The slower first boy began running to third, as per the coach's request. The second boy was faster and passed him between 2rd and 3rd base. The coach yelled, "Go back. Go back." So, the first boy promptly went back to 2rd base. The coach then yelled, "Not you, you keep coming." So, the second player rounded 3rd and headed for home to score. The first boy found himself standing on 3rd base. Meanwhile, the ball had been thrown all over the infield with a half dozen errors being committed and no "outs" recorded.

So many rules were broken. What should be done? Some parents in the stands had very loud and specific opinions. The 17-year-old coaches got together at home-plate, conferred for a few minutes, shrugged their shoulders and said, "Play ball!" There would be time to teach these youngsters the rules.
