


Dear Church Family,

## Remembering the Holocaust 4/18/2023

April 18<sup>th</sup> is national Holocaust Remembrance Day. It is a day intentionally set aside to recall the millions of innocent people who were mercilessly killed. The word "holocaust" elicits strong emotions. And it should. The basic meaning is, "*destruction or slaughter on a mass scale, especially caused by fire or nuclear war.*" In describing the holocaust that happened during WWII the dictionary also included these words, "*the* 

mass murder of Jewish people under the German Nazi regime during the period 1941–45. More than 6 million European Jews, as well as members of other persecuted groups such as Romani, gay people, and disabled people, were murdered at concentration camps such as Auschwitz."

What I did not know was that the dictionary also included a historical meaning for the word holocaust. A holocaust is, "A Jewish sacrificial offering that was burned completely on an altar." Wow! That means God expected His Hebrew children to participate in a holocaust to atone for their sins. They had to burn an unblemished, sacrificial lamb. That shed blood covered their sin and provided forgiveness.

Granted, Christians don't live under the O.T. system. But there is still a blood sacrifice required if we want our sins forgiven. Jesus paid that sin debt for us. Now, we are required to lose our life in Jesus. Three gospel writers quote Jesus as saying, *"For those who want to save their life will lose it, but those who lose their life for my sake will find it."* (Matthew 16:25; Mark 8:35; Luke 9:24). How do we lose our life? We die to self and live to Christ so that He can free us from an eternal holocaust.

There is another holocaust every Christian must endure. The Holy Spirit burns away the "dross" and purifies our faith **(1 Peter 1:6-7.)** Are you willing to undergo spiritual holocaust so that you may live for Jesus?
