Why Don't Caterpillars Fly? 5/16/2023

A Sunday school teacher drew her student's attention to **Luke 9:28-36**, the passage discussing the transfiguration event in Jesus' life. She mentioned that the word, transfiguration, is a big word that means, "change." Jesus' face shone like the sun, and he was able to converse with the dead (specifically, Moses and Elijah.) She said that the change that happened to Jesus was sort of like the change that happens when a caterpillar becomes a butterfly. In fact, the Greek word for transfiguration is another big word, metamorphosis. Then she asked if the students had learned that word in science class. Many students nodded in the affirmative.

One curious student innocently asked, "Why don't caterpillars fly?" The whole process of a caterpillar eating non-stop, building a cocoon and changing into a butterfly seemed so inefficient. Why didn't God just give caterpillars wings and forget all the other stuff.

The teacher paused a moment then said, "God never wanted caterpillars to fly. He wanted butterflies to fly. God put within the caterpillar the ability to change into a butterfly so it could fly as God intended. If a caterpillar decided to refuse God's power to change, they will never fly. It's kind of like that with Christians. All people are born with a sin nature. But God wants us to feast on His word and, by faith, accept Jesus as our Savior. God's Spirit will dwell in us and transform us into what God intended us to be, believers who reflect His glory. If a person refuses to be changed by God's Spirit that person will never be what God wants them to be. The Spirit is trying to convict everyone of sin. But, we need to submit to God's transforming power. Caterpillars who remain that way will never fly and unbelievers who remain that way will never fly with God."
