Craftsman's Lifetime Warranty 5/30/2023

At age 18, I worked in the hardware department of a Sears & Roebuck store. At that time, Sears was where you could buy *Craftsman* tools. Every tool came with a lifetime warranty. If the tool broke or failed, Sears would replace it.

One day a customer brought in a pair of *Craftsman* vice grips. They had failed because they were covered with rust. I told the customer that the warranty covered structural failure, not rust. The man was insistent that, since he could clearly see the *Craftsman* brand name on the handle, it should be covered. I called my manager. He confirmed that the man was right. The visible name on the tool meant that we would replace it.

As I wrote up the ticket, I asked the man where he had found the tool. He replied that he had bought a used car about 3 years earlier, and was recently under the car checking the exhaust when he noticed the vice grip firmly attached to the car's frame. How long it had been there was anyone's guess. He never thought we'd replace the tool but figured it was worth a try since, he could see the name clearly.

There is a spiritual parallel here. Anyone who bears the name of Jesus on their life has entered into a covenant that carries with it certain guarantees. We are promised that the Holy Spirit will dwell in us to teach, guide, protect and convict us of our sin. We are promised rest in Jesus.
