Flag Day is All About Unity 6/6/2023

It was early 1775. The American Revolution was just getting started. The British army was fighting against the 13 colonies. Each colony provided soldiers who fought under their own colony's flag. General George Washington realized that their best hope for defeating the British was if every soldier fought as a unified Continental Army, under one "American" flag.

Unfortunately, the first flag was comprised of 13 red and white alternating stripes and a Union Jack in the corner. Washington realized that flying a flag that so closely resembled the British flag was not a great confidence-builder for the revolutionary effort. So, he sought a new symbol of freedom for the fledgling nation. He turned to Francis Hopkinson, a delegate from New Jersey who signed the Declaration of Independence, to design the American flag.

On June 14, 1777, the Second Continental Congress took a break from writing the Articles of Confederation and passed a resolution stating that "the flag of the United States be 13 stripes, alternate red and white," and that "the union be 13 stars, white in a blue field, representing a new constellation."

On June 14, 1916, President Woodrow Wilson marked the anniversary of that decree, and established June 14 as a national holiday known as Flag Day.

As Christians we are called to war against Satan. If we try to fight under the banner of our own church or denomination, we will fail. That is why God gave us the banner of the cross of Jesus Christ and His finished work of salvation through His blood, as the unifying flag under which we are to fight. If unity is imperative for a nation to be successful against her enemies, unity is even more necessary if we are to battle the spiritual forces of darkness. May God be glorified by our unity.
