

"The Sound of Freedom" 7/11/2023

On July 4th Angel Studios released a movie titled *Sound of Freedom.* Judy and I saw it on July 8th and we highly recommend it. It is a difficult movie to watch because it elicits a wide range of emotions. It is based on the true story of Tim Ballard and his fight against child sex-trafficking. It is a story that needs to be told and listened to because the statistics are staggering. Currently there are 5 million children trapped in forced sexual exploitation globally. One phrase that is heard loud and clear in the movie is, "God's children are not for sale."

Jim Caviezel, who stars in the movie as Tim Ballard, also portrayed Jesus in the movie, *The Passion of Christ,* directed 19 years ago by Mel Gibson. Not only does Jim encourage strong social justice activity from the viewers, he bases that justice in a strong, biblical faith. That this issue is even present in our world speaks to the darkness and blindness Satan has cast over greedy, self-serving, self-absorbed, hedonistic, and sex-driven humans. Sadly, this evil is the fastest growing international crime network the world has ever seen. And it is consumer driven.

These powerless, innocent, children are intimidated, drugged, abused and sold over and over so that people with no moral compass can exploit them. Caviezel stated that Abraham Lincoln credited Harriet Beecher Stowe, with her story of *Uncle Tom's Cabin* published in 1852, as the springboard story which prompted people to rise up to end legal slavery in the USA. This story might just be the catalyst to help end child sex-trafficking.
