Some of the more popular items are: canned vegetables, canned fruit, salad dressings, cereals, toilet paper and boxed pasta meals.



Words of Great Price 8/14/2023

The phrase, "talk is cheap" means that it is easier to talk about doing something than it is to actually do it. Sometimes the phrase is used as a challenge to move a braggart from verbal promises to actually following through on their vow. As Christians, it is vital that our words carry the value God wants them to have.

Romans 10:14, "How can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?" Verbal proclamation is God's chosen vehicle through which the gospel comes to the unsaved. Our words are valuable, and we must see them as significant and priceless to God.

King Solomon reminds us of the value of our words and urges us to use them judiciously:

Proverbs 10:19 - When words are many, sin is not absent, but he who holds his tongue is wise.

Proverbs 11:12 - A man who lacks judgment derides his neighbor, but a man of understanding holds his tongue.

Proverbs 12:18 - Reckless words pierce like a sword, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.

Proverbs 15:2 - The tongue of the wise commends knowledge, but the mouth of the fool gushes folly.

Proverbs 18:2 - A fool finds no pleasure in understanding but delights in airing his own opinions.

Proverbs 18:13 - He who answers before listening – that is his folly and his shame.

Proverbs 20:19 - A gossip betrays a confidence; so, avoid a man who talks too much.

Space prevents a larger discourse on what scripture says about our speech patterns. Just know that our words are so valuable, many of the commandments are built around what we say and how we say it.

Colossians 4:6 – Let your conversation be always full of grace, tasty like a preservative, so that you may know how to answer everyone.
