Wrestling with God 10/17/2023

His name is Jacob. He is the grandson of Abraham. That pedigree doesn't prevent him from having a less-than-sterling reputation. He deceived his brother twice, his father once and his father-in-law at least once. Of course, he was deceived by his father-in-law. So, turn about is fair play, I guess. He is one of those Bible characters we can all relate to. When he gets caught in his deceit he runs away. 20 years have past. He is told that Esau is approaching. He seems trapped. In that moment, he wrestles with God.


Jacob isn't the only one to wrestle with God. Samson had a real "come to God" moment when he was weak, blind, and in chains. Job cried out to God, in the midst of his unprecedented tragedy, asking that question that baffles everyone, "WHY?" Even in the New Testament, Peter had to wrestle with his guilt when he heard the rooster crow, following his three-fold denials.

We've all been where these heroes of the faith were. In Jacob's case, the wrestling was not mental or emotional alone. It was quite physical. Scripture says that Jacob and the Lord wrestled all night. And, when it was all over, Jacob was a new man. He was given a new name and a new purpose. Oh, yeah, and a new limp. When we are confronted by God, He might not remove our inadequacies. He may even give us a new handicap, just to remind us that He is sovereign.

The Apostle Paul knew this first-hand. He prayed for God to remove a "thorn in my side." Instead, God reminded him, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness" (2 Corinthians 12:9).

When God wrestles away our pride and ego, it is a good thing. Only when we are weak, and humbly dependent on God, can He do His best work in us.
