## Responding to Halloween 10/31/2023

Today is Halloween. It is celebrated all over the world as a night that glorifies evil and desensitizes children to things that the enemy, Satan, loves. Am I being too harsh? Some say, "Yes!" as they point out the fun costumes, delightful lights, party atmosphere and smiles on children's faces as they receive their "treats." What's the harm? Besides, we can redeem the holiday by wearing Bible costumes and having a Harvest Party, right?

So, how should a Christian respond to Halloween? How can we show love and not legalism on this Holiday?

**First**, remember that, unless your celebration includes divination, seances, witchcraft, sorcery, devil worship, or anything else scripture directly condemns, there are no biblical directives on whether you should participate in a Halloween Party. So be careful not to judge those who choose to celebrate. And don't judge those who choose not to celebrate. This truly is a matter of conscience.

**Second**, remember that we are not fighting against flesh and blood, but against the principalities of darkness in this world. Our enemy is not the children dressed as police officers, princesses or even the occasional witch. It is Satan and the hold he has on people's lives.

**Third**, be a representative of Christ and shed His love and light. Maybe that means handing out a gospel tract, or saying, "Jesus loves you!" to each child who gets the candy. We connect with people when we try to find common ground. Even Paul said (1 Cor 9:22) that he became all things to all people so that by all possible means he might save some.

**Last**, if, through Halloween you meet a new neighbor, follow up with them. Visit them and learn of their faith journey. Re-connect and build a new relationship with them and their children. They may not even have a home church and your invitation is just what they were looking for.

Halloween may still be a dark day. By shedding the light of Christ on the day, you can help dispel the darkness.
