A Candle of the Day or a Candle of the Night 12/19/2023

Christmas is a time for lights and candles. In a devotional written by Jonathan Cahn, he talks about the light of a candle. Cahn notes that, in the day, the candle's light is in harmony with the light of day. This is like a Christian shining brightly among other Christians in a culture of faith. The believer's light blends easily with its surroundings. "But," Cahn writes, "The candle in the night represents the believer who shines in the midst of a post-Christian civilization, an apostate civilization, an anti-Christian, anti-biblical, anti-God civilization. The light of the gospel is no longer in harmony with the surrounding culture. In fact, the culture stands increasingly in opposition to the light. The light cannot blend in. It must now increasingly stand out in contrast to its surroundings, and increasingly shine against the flow."

It was into a dark world that Jesus came to be the light. He didn't come to blend in with the darkness, but to shine and dispel the darkness. The candle that shines in the daylight can hardly be seen. The candle that shines in darkness can be seen miles away.

At the darkest times of your life, when it seems impossible to shine for God, *that* is when it is needed the most. The deeper the darkness, the more powerful the light is. Jesus reminds us of this truth in Matt 5:14 -16, You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hidden. Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead, they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.
