## It Keeps our Imagination Grounded 2/27/2024

Watching children who have a vivid imagination is interesting. One minute they are holding a toy dinosaur and living in the Jurassic era. The next minute they are wearing an eye patch and talking like a pirate. They may see themselves on a battleship while wearing a sailor's hat. Or, herding wild Mustangs while wearing cowboy boots. Give them a toy rocket and they are hurtling through space on their way to Mars. Or allow them to hold a die cast police car and the chase is on as they set out to apprehend the "bad guys." It doesn't matter if the object is the real thing. Sticks make a more than adequate sword for Sir Lancelot. And a stuffed animal is ferocious except for the young lion tamer. The child's imagination is encouraged by the objects that connect with their senses.

Jesus employed the same tactic to encourage the imagination of His followers. As Jesus approached the fulfillment of His mission on the cross, he wanted his disciples to remember, to use their imagination, and to keep in mind all that He was doing. He gave them a couple of small, tangible articles (bread and wine) to engage their minds and encourage their imagination.

2,000 years later, Jesus still urges every believer to touch, taste, smell and see these representations of the real thing and be mentally teleported back to the day when Jesus allowed his body to be broken and his blood shed. Jesus is okay with believers who have a vivid imagination. He encourages it with the objects He provided. And he desires that these objects keep our imaginations grounded in truth.

So, go ahead. Engage your imagination every time you participate in communion. It is a beautiful time of hope and fulfillment.
