Work for the Night is Coming 3/5/2024

On Sunday, March 10th at 2:00 a.m. the clocks are to be turned one hour forward. This is known as Daylight Saving Time. DST was first introduced in 1918 but it only lasted one year and then was repealed. Its biggest opponent was farmers. History.com says that farmers farm by the sun and not the clock anyway. So, changing the clock was very disruptive. DST was reintroduced in 1942 during WWII. But, it wasn't until 1966 when The Uniform Time Act was passed which established nationwide standards for the observance of DST. The real purpose of DST was to conserve energy by matching daylight hours to the times when most people are awake.

Jesus had something to say about working when it is daylight. John 9:4 We must work the works of Him who sent Me as long as it is day; night is coming when no one can work.

This statement is spoken on the heels of Jesus healing a man who was born blind. Jesus told his disciples that the blindness wasn't because of sin, but so that the works of God might be displayed (John 9:3). Then, following his statement in vs. 4, Jesus explains that, while He is in the world, He is the Light of the world (John 9:5).

Just as Jesus brought sight and light into the physical life of the man born blind. Only Jesus can cure the spiritual blindness caused by the darkness of a world ruled by the prince of darkness, Satan. Jesus is challenging His listeners that they should be doing the work of God as long as it is day; as long as Jesus, the Light of the world, is there. Jesus urges us to continue to work to expand His kingdom now because night is coming.
