God Loves You Because He Wants To 4/16/2024

A young couple sat in my office. Exuberance radiating from their faces. I asked them to respond to the question, "Why do you want to get married?" After a bit of a pause, the man said, "Because we love each other, and we want to spend our lives together." Not a bad response. But I pressed the question one step further. "What is this love of which you speak?" The couple shifted uncomfortably. They were sure I was looking for a specific answer, but they were baffled as to what that might be. After a moment of silence, I let them off the hook by saying, "The Bible tells us that God is love. That means that love is spiritual and originates from God. If you say you love someone, you are really saying that you intend to act Godly towards them." Then I asked, "Do you know why God chose to love you?" After some hesitation, the woman ventured a timid, "Because he wanted to?" I smiled and said, "You could not have spoken truer words."

God loves us because he wants to. Not because of our work ethic, our intellect, our dedication, our heritage, our generosity, or our willpower. God chose to love you because, in grace, he wants to. We didn't earn God's love. We can't merit God's love. We don't deserve God's love. All we can do is receive God's love as a gift and respond to it.

How will you respond to God choosing to love you? Will you rebel, reject, ignore or refuse that love. OR, will you live in that love, react to that love with humble submission, return God's love by loving his word, his people, his church, the lost, his Spirit, and his Son?

Say it out loud, "God chose to love me because he wanted to." Now, bask in that truth.
