Darkened in their Hearts 4/9/2024

Well, the total solar eclipse happened yesterday, we are still here, and the Lord's second coming is still on the horizon. Which means that we have work to do for God's kingdom.

If you watched the eclipse, hopefully you saw it as a wonderful way to draw close to God's power proclaimed through His creation. Unfortunately, too many people will not see God's power. Their eyes are not on God, but elsewhere. The apostle Paul says it this way... Ephesians 4:18 - They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Paul is talking about pagan Gentiles who had "given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, and they are full of greed." That description could apply to many in our culture today. Something is getting in the way of people seeing the SON!

Paul's challenge to the Christians in Ephesus is that, if they are to live for Christ, they have to always live in the light of Christ. Anything that stands between them and Jesus must be discarded. The same is true in our culture. We must not let anything darken our understanding of God or harden our heart. When the moon came between earth and the sun, there was darkness and a chill was in the air. When we allow the things of this world to come between us and the Son of God, the result will be spiritual darkness and Coldness and a darkness that will only be removed when we allow the light of God's Son to shine in our life to soften our hard hearts and dispel our spiritual obscurity.

Praise the Lord that Jesus, the light of life, shines his will for all to see and live in.
