Summer Sunday School Classes 5/14/2024

This is an invitation for you to join us each week for Sunday school 10:45-11:30 a.m. We have classes for all ages, including three adult classes. Bob Dowler and Brenda Elam teach classes using the *Standard Lesson Commentary*. Their lessons will focus on the topic "*Hope in the Lord*."

Beginning May 26th, I will be leading an adult class through a book titled *Celebration of Discipline: The Path to Spiritual Growth*. The book was originally written by Richard J. Foster in 1978. It was updated in 2018 (the version we will be using). While discipline tends to carry negative connotations, everyone understands why it is necessary. In 1 Corinthians 9:27, Paul describes how he disciplines his own body, so that what he does in the body does not disqualify his preaching. He wants his walk and his talk to match. The writer of Hebrews 12 uses the chapter to describe how the Lord disciplines us for our good. Discipline can be painful, but its results are generally very positive.

Foster says that the problem spiritual people have is superficiality. He encourages Christians to become "deep" people. We can be the answer to a shallow world through the "classical disciplines." Foster divides the book into 3 discipline areas: Inward Disciplines like prayer, fasting, meditation and study; Outward Disciplines like simplicity, solitude, submission and service; and Corporate Disciplines like worship, guidance, confession and celebration. While these disciplines will not save us, and only the Holy Spirit can transform us into Christlikeness, practicing these disciplines will assist us as we run the race of faith.

Did you know that FCC averages close to 65% of our people who come for our worship gathering will stay for Sunday school? What an amazing testimony to our teachers and the passion FCC has for helping everyone learn as a disciple of Jesus.
