The Four Spiritual Flaws 6/11/2024

While reading an article I came across something written by Chuck Swindoll. Swindoll called them the Four Spiritual Flaws and they go like this:

- 1) Because you are a Christian, all your problems are solved.
- 2) All the problems you will ever have are addressed in the Bible.
- 3) If you are having problems, you are somehow unspiritual.
- 4) Being exposed to sound Bible teaching automatically solves all your problems.

Just reading through these statements, you can easily see the flaws in this sort of reasoning.

#1 is flawed because it leads people into self-reliance. Besides, Satan attacks Christians. He seeks to destroy believers. Being a Christian doesn't solve all our problems- it often leads to greater struggles. The truth is... 1 John 4:4 - the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world.

#2 is flawed because there are modern-day problems the Bible doesn't address. If your computer crashes, you need technical support. Dealing with your impatience because your computer is down does require connection to God's word. Proverbs 14:19 – A patient person has great understanding, but a quick-tempered person displays foolishness.

#3 is often promoted by the "health and wealth" religion. They might say, "If you have a physical malady, it is due to a lack of faith." Or, "If you are poverty-stricken, you are not spiritual enough." Think about the man of God named Job, in the Old Testament (Job 1 & 2). He had lots of problems because he was faithful to God, not because his faith was weak.

#4 is flawed because hearing Bible teaching is not the same as obeying what it teaches. **James 1:22** reminds us, Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.

The easiest way to avoid spiritual flaws is to fully embrace God's word and the truth therein.
