Ray Weaver- in Carle Hospital, has some fractures in his legs and back, causing pain; he also has a bad case of COVID



Let it Go? 7/23/2024

On November 27, 2013 a Disney movie was released entitled *Frozen*. One of the shows iconic musical selections is titled. "Let it Go." The piece was written by Idina Menzel, who was the voice of Elsa in the film. The lyrics speak of Elsa's freedom to finally be the ice queen she believes she was always meant to be. Of course, in her ice palace, she is alone and has isolated herself from everyone else. At least she can do what she wants. All she had to do was let go of her entire past and justify it as a good thing. At this point in the movie, Elsa is very self-centered, prideful and egotistical. The song's lyrics demonstrate that fully. Thankfully, by the movie's end, Elsa realizes that she needs her sister, Anna. She sees value in holding on to some of the good things in her past.



We all have things in our past we should let go of. When we have been hurt, betrayed, lied to, etc., we have a choice: relive it daily, rehash the wounds, repeat the pain and make our anger our identity. Or, we can learn to, "Let it go!" There is a great deal of psychological benefit in letting resentment go. Resentment is truly self-torture. Someone said, "Resentment is like drinking poison and expecting the other person to die." We need only look to Jesus who, from the cross, asked God to forgive those causing him pain. He released his grip on anger and "Let it go."

The Bible teaches that we cannot receive what we are unwilling to give. Jesus taught (Matt 6:14-15) that we must be willing to forgive others, if we want God to forgive us. If we want God to let our sinful past go. we need to live out that same truth.

Let go of past hurts. Not for selfish reasons, but for the glory of God, so that you may experience blessed times of refreshment.
