# Wealthy... Just Don't Know It 8/20/2024

From September 1962 until 1971, a TV show known as *The Beverly Hillbillies* was aired on CBS stations. The events of the show begin with Jed Clampit "discovering" oil on his property, when an errant shot penetrated the ground and "black gold, Texas tea" bubbled up. Jed sold the oil to a petrochemical company for 25 million dollars and moved to Beverly Hills, CA with his mother (Granny); his daughter, Elly May, and his wayward cousin, Jethro Bodine, who felt compelled to be the brains of the family given his 6th-grade education.

The TV show is fiction, right? Not exactly. According to *Wikipedia*, Ira and Ann Yates lived a hardscrabble life on a west Texas ranch they owned. Yates was having difficulty making sufficient profit to pay the mortgage and taxes. On a hunch, he invited Michael Late Benedum's Transcontinental Oil Co. to explore his land. In 1926, a partnership consisting of Mid-Kansas Oil Company and Transcontinental drilled an exploratory well, the Yates No. 1-A. At approximately 1,000 feet, they hit a rich productive zone, producing a "gusher." Almost 100 years later, the Yates oil field is still producing millions of barrels. The Yates family is worth 2.5 billion dollars.

Some say Yates became a billionaire overnight. Actually, Yates was a billionaire the minute he signed the papers buying the land. He just didn't know it.

Some Christians might be living in that predicament. **Ephesians 1:3** reminds us that God has *"blessed us with every spiritual blessing in Christ Jesus."* Unfortunately, many do not live like they have "every spiritual blessing." They are oblivious to the riches of God's grace, the lavishness of his mercy, the completeness of his forgiveness, the generosity of his provisions, the fullness of his love and the wholeness of his salvation. Having never tapped into God's riches, they try to scratch out a spiritual life, but believe they are destined to live spiritually poor.

Don't wait. Tap into the gusher of spiritual blessing in Christ. Live the full life God has given you.
