

Reflections on 10 years of Ministry 8/26/2024

Monday, August 25, 2014, Judy and I moved to Villa Grove, IL. We arrived at 6:30 p.m. on a very hot day, and began unloading the U-Haul. At 7 p.m., we endured a thunder and lightning storm. By 8:00 p.m., the crew of 20 or more people had set up most of the rooms and put boxes where they needed to be. My first sermon on August 31st was titled, *I Love the Church*. This past Sunday the congregation honored our 10th anniversary with a cupcake reception and gift cards.

During the past 10 years, we have seen 32 baptisms and 14 transfers of membership to FCC. We have celebrated 5 weddings. And, sadly, I have officiated at 79 funerals, with half of them being members of the church. The COVID-19 shut-down hit us hard, as several families left the church. However, God has blessed us with new families and new faces and our attendance hovers around 90 people.

In 10 years, the church building has been upgraded and maintained well. We replaced the roof, repainted the sanctuary, replaced the sound system, computers, water heater, lawn mower, commercial refrigerator, and 6 HVAC units. We have added hallway railings, an outdoor pavilion, new driveway pillars, LED lighting throughout the building inside and out. We remodeled the fellowship hall and men's restroom. PLUS, the parsonage has a new center structural beam, hot water boiler, AC compressor, water heater, sump pump, two remodeled bathrooms, and a new concrete driveway. I've likely forgotten other upgrades. God has blessed FCC with generous donors and hard workers, and our facilities are in top shape.

Our leadership continues to grow in their faith, skills and unity. Though some people have stepped away from leadership roles and specific ministries, we continue to teach all ages in Sunday school, provide a Youth Group for our teens, grow our Women's Christian Fellowship, teach people in mid-week Bible Studies, provide an area wide Easter Cantata and offer our building and grounds to be used by the community and school.

Our goal is to always be faithful to God's truth. To work with all our might. To be available for church and community. And to be free to serve with our giftedness, so that a sin-darkened world might see the light of Christ. Thank you for the last decade of ministering alongside Judy and me. We love you all deeply.
