Struggle Leads to Strength 8/6/2024

The 2024 Olympics are in full swing. Thousands of athletes are swimming, biking, running, lifting, rowing, tumbling, shooting, throwing, kicking, even speed walking. Four nations sent only one athlete to the games while the USA sent 592. Regardless of the resources, each athlete must put in the time, pain and struggle to reach the goal of competing at the highest level. They struggle knowing it will build strength.

Scripture frequently uses athletic metaphors in talking about the Christian life. Athletes establish a training regimen, knowing that the struggle will lead to planned growth. However, some struggles, like breaking a bone, tearing a ligament or battling an internal disease, are surprises. The athletes who overcome, find a new strength. As disciples of Jesus, we plan for growth in prayer, love, forgiveness, etc. knowing our struggle will lead to strength. But, some struggles are thrust upon us. We lose a job, experience a betrayal, are devastated by a broken relationship, etc.

In August 2022, Christian singer Toby Mac released a song titled, *Faithfully*. He speaks of life being good and things going well. Then it all falls apart. Verse 2 of the song goes, "I've had a hard time findin' the blue in the skies above me. And if I'm keepin' it real, I been half-fakin' the happy they see. I may look like the same man. But I'm half the man I was. It's been a hard year. It almost took me down." The song concludes by stating that God is always faithful. He sees us, knows us, and helps us through our struggle. We will never be who we were. God helps us to be stronger.

James 1:2-4 reminds us, Consider it pure joy, my brothers whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance. Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
