



Forgiveness is Supernatural 10/15/2024

This is a true story. On December 20, 1974, Christopher Carrier, age 10, stepped off his school bus and vanished. Six days later, a hunter found him 75 miles from home, sitting on a rock in the Florida Everglades. Someone had stabbed him repeatedly with an ice pick, burned him with cigarettes, then shot him. The bullet had entered Chris' right temple, exiting through his left eye.

The prime suspect was David McAllister, an ex-convict who was a nurse, tending to Chris' elderly uncle. Chris' father had fired David for drinking on the job. McAllister was furious. Police received a composite sketch from Chris that resembled McAllister. But there was no hard evidence to link David to the crime.

22 years later, a Detective who had worked the unsolved case came to Chris and told him that McAllister, who was now 77, was near death and living in a nursing home. Chris made arrangements to visit McAllister and McAllister confessed that he was the abductor. Instead of bitterness toward the man who put a bullet through his skull, leaving him blind in one eye, Chris forgave the man. He visited his kidnapper every day until David died a few weeks later, read the Bible to him and forged an unlikely friendship. "Nobody could imagine that I would shake the hand that tried to kill me," Chris told *The Miami Herald*. "When I look at him, I don't stare at my abductor and potential murderer. I stare at a man, very old, very alone and scared. He's never been able to live without memories, guilt and pain. In that perspective, he has paid the price for his sins and served his time." Chris' power to forgive came "Through my faith in Jesus."

Matthew 6:14-15: For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. Bit if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins.

Forgiveness is always possible, because it is supernatural.
