

Parent/Teacher Conference 10/22/2024

This week is the end of the first quarter of the school year. Grades have been recorded and parents or guardians are urged to come to a parent/teacher conference. The purpose of these conferences is to open a channel of dialogue where factors that can affect the student's learning are discussed. It is also an opportunity to talk about the child's behavioral and social development, standardized test results, peer relationships, work habits, as well as help the teacher learn more about the student's home-life, strengths and challenges.

I remember going to these events when my children were in public school. Their academic achievement was never an issue. Often the conference was short, as our kids liked school, had friends, enjoyed extra-curricular activities and basically did well. We accepted our responsibility of being intentionally involved in our children's education, and communicated with the teachers, to encourage them, as well as voice concerns.

Not all parents are involved in their child's education, and not all children love school. Not every teacher is the best fit for a child's learning skills. And not all students get along well with others. Thus communication is vital.

I wonder what a Sunday school version of a parent/teacher conference would look like? Would the teacher be concerned when talking about the student's progress in Bible education? Would the parents be engaged and intentional about helping their child learn the ways of the Lord? Would the parents be concerned because their child had missed too many Sunday school classes? Would the teacher feel free to challenge the parents to be actively involved in learning the Bible with their children? Will both parents and teachers feel confident that we are doing all we can to urge our children to be a disciple of Jesus in obedience to the Great Commission? I wonder?
