Living by Faith Sermon Series 1/7/2025

Hebrews 12:1 says: Since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off the sin that so easily entangles us...

Who are these witnesses? What kind of life did they live that prompts the author to put them forth as examples for us to emulate? Both answers are found in the previous chapter. Some have called Hebrews 11 The Hall of Faith, or the Heroes of Faith. Each of these examples have been given because they didn't just say they believed. Rather, they lived by faith. Faith was as natural for them as breathing. And the author offers them to his Hebraic readers as witnesses to the reality that faith can be lived out in everyone who claims to be a disciple of Jesus.

Over the next 5 months, we will look at these examples. Last Sunday, we began with Abel's Offering (Gen 4:1-15). In coming weeks, we will look at Enoch's Commendation (Gen 5:22); Noah's Holy Fear (Gen 6:14-22); Abraham's Vision (Gen 12:1-7); Abraham & Sarah's Submission (Gen 18:11-14); Isaac's Blessing (Gen 27:27-29); Jacob's Worship (Gen 49); Joseph's Freedom (Gen 50); Amram & Jochebed's Parental Care (Exodus 2:2); Moses' Choices (Exodus 2:10-11); Israel's Actions (Exodus 14:21-31 & Joshua 6:12-20); Rahab's Hospitality (Joshua 2:9); Gideon's Commitment (Judges 7:21); Samson's Redemption (Judges 16:28); the Faith of the Judges (like Barak); the Faith of the Kings (like David); the Faith of the Prophets (like Samuel); The Faith of the Martyrs (Hebrews 11:35-38); and Our Faith as we await God's Coming (Hebrews 11:39-40).

Do you wish to be a deeper disciple of Jesus? Learn from those whose lives are comprised of faith, not evidence, proof or substance alone. Rather a faith that moves mountains, a faith that doesn't have to be big, but grows large, a faith that pleases God. Living by faith should be every Christian's resolution as long as we are on earth.
