The animated TV series *Phineas and Ferb* was made by Disney Television Animation in August of 2007. The series follows stepbrothers Phineas Flynn and Ferb Fletcher who, according to their theme song, realize: There's 104 days of summer vacation 'til school comes along just to end it. So the annual problem for our generation, is finding a good way to spend it. The boys spend every summer day constructing grand projects or embarking on amazing adventures.

As fantastical and improbable as the show is, it speaks of a common issue in our world. People look forward to "summer," so they can get away from the institutions of everyday life and participate in something amazing. We get away from work and take a vacation. We leave the commonness of our house and live in a camper. We escape the sameness of our hometown and travel to exotic locations, do amazing things, and see memorable sights. We unplug and want the craziness of daily life to just stop.

Christians often do the same thing. In summer, we want to "get away" from the "institution" of weekly worship and ministry so we can enjoy 3 months of projects and amazing adventures. Pastors call this the "summer slump" and it is a real thing. Don't misunderstand me. There is nothing wrong with taking advantage of the summer weather to refresh, rejuvenate and recharge. However, there is a danger. Unlike school, which mandates a student's return in the fall, when summer ends, it is not required that people return to worship gatherings or ministry. The danger is that, once we have stopped our spiritual motion, we will want to stay stopped.



Isaac Newton's first law of inertia states that: Objects at rest stay at rest and objects in motion stay in motion unless acted upon by an external force. Satan is a crafty external force urging Christians to stay at rest from spiritual growth. Fortunately, God's Holy Spirit is the force we need to keep us moving forward. Listen to that prompting. During the summer, even if you are away from your home church, find a church to attend, read your bible, go on a mission trip, study a topic, take the youth fishing, move forward in your spiritual growth.
