# Free From Paralysis 7/15/2025


In John 5:1-9, a paralyzed man is lying near the pool of Bethesda in Jerusalem. He has been stuck for 38 years. He is hoping someone will come along and help him into the pool when the water is stirred so that he could possibly be healed. Did healing actually happen at that pool? We aren't told. We do know there were "a great number of blind, lame and paralyzed" people who put their hope in the healing potential of this football-field sized pool. Only the ones lucky enough to get in first had a shot.

Into this throng of disease, pain, and stench that filled the five colonnades, Jesus walked. Jesus was in Jerusalem to celebrate a feast with his disciples. But, this day, he walked among the outcasts alone. We don't know if he spoke to anyone else. When he came to this man He asked a strange guestion, "Do you want to get well?" The man replied by telling Jesus the facts. No one will help him. Others get there first. His hopes have been dashed for decades. He doesn't ask Jesus for help. Yet Jesus knows his heart and commands him, "Pick up your mat and walk." Paralysis is gone. 38 years of hopelessness is erased in a second. The man leaves the pool and is confronted by Jews who demand he point out the one who healed him "on the Sabbath." When the man tried Jesus was gone.

Later, Jesus saw the man in the temple. And said to him, "Stop sinning or something worse will happen to you." What could be worse? How about an eternity of spiritual paralysis.

Many are stuck in sin and only Jesus can free them. And he will if you want it. Though we may have struggled for years Jesus has the power to overcome our hopelessness. The question is, "Do you want to

> get well?" When Jesus does free you, will you move forward in faith and stop sinning. Make the right choice. Be free from your spiritual paralysis, stop sinning and live.
