

Larry Kincaid (husband of Bob Dowler's cousin)- is doing fine, no heart issues


Nicole Kneer- cancer treatments

# Hiding From God? 9/23/2025

Who doesn't love a good game of Hide-and-Seek? Children love to believe they are completely hidden from everyone even though their feet can be seen beneath the curtains and their giggles give away their position.

Sadly, not all who hide are playing games. Adam and Eve tried to hide from God after they sinned. Achan tried to hide his sin of stealing plunder. Even Jacob's wife, Rachel, stole items from her father and lied about it. Who among us hasn't sinned and tried to hide the evidence. We may be able to fool humans. But we can never fool God. In **Jeremiah 23:24** God says, "Can anyone hide in secret places so that I cannot see him?" declares the Lord. "Do I not fill heaven and earth?" declares the Lord.

It seems so obvious that nothing is hidden from God. The Old Testament man, Job, realized this fully when he said, "There is no darkness or deep shadow where the workers of iniquity may hide themselves." (Job 34:22)

Jonah tried to run and hide from God's ministry call on his life. That didn't go well for him. Ananias and Sapphira tried to hide part of the money they had decided to give to the early church. That really didn't go well for them. And, in Jesus' parable of the talents (Matt 25:14-30), one servant hid what the master had given him and tried to justify it by pointing at the master's character. That didn't go well for him either.

The point is, why do we keep trying to hide our sin from God? Rather, we should be open and honest with our behaviors. Take responsibility, confess our sins, repent, seek forgiveness, be reconciled and live in the grace, mercy, and forgiveness of our God.

Paul summed it up wonderfully. Gal. 6:7 – "Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked (fooled). A man reaps what he sows."
