Connecting to the Son 10/7/2025

Between Ashmore, IL and Kansas, IL is a solar farm consisting of 1,600 acres of solar panels. The largest solar farm in the U.S.A. is in California, and takes up 4,700 acres of land. Currently, over 2,200 counties in the U.S. have solar farms. This may seem like a lot. However, experts say that it would only take about one-half of 1% of all the land available in the USA to fuel every house in the USA with solar energy. Putting panels on the roof of every single-family dwelling will only get us halfway there. That doesn't even count other forms of green energy. The nice thing is that, in the U.S., there is very little to prohibit citizens from accessing solar power.

Why talk about solar energy? Simply this... It doesn't matter how many panels are set up or how much electricity they produce, if the panels are not hooked into the power grid or connected to transmission lines, they are useless. For solar panels to do what they are designed to do, they must connect with something that needs power. The lights of our homes will not shine if they are not connected to an accessible power source.

The same is true in the life of a Christian. Most people in the U.S. have access to a Bible. Unfortunately, Bible illiteracy is at an all-time high. It doesn't matter how many Bibles you have or how readily accessible a Bible is to you on your phone. If you are not reading the Bible, if you are not connected to God's word, the Holy Spirit will be hampered as he tries to transmit Godly power into your spiritual life. God calls us to be the light of the world. To do that, we must be connected to the source of real power, Jesus, the son of God.
